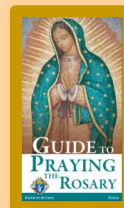

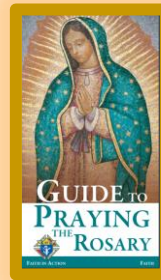

We've all heard the phrase, "The Lord works in mysterious ways."

We've also heard, "one door closes that another one opens."

In all our lives we have friends, some of those will become close friends, and over years, a few of those will become family.

In my life one of those became brother to me, second only to my blood brother, Richard. This past August 26th after a two-year battle with cancer, he went home to Our Lord.

I want to tell you a little of his battle because, as it always happens, these things impact many others over several degrees of separation. But it also provides an opportunity to see how the Lord works, if we would just look.

It was heart-breaking to watch him go thru these last two years, knowing his pain was getting increasingly worse. But it was just as hard to watch his wife, a woman who had become to Pam what he was to me, family, to watch her go thru what she was dealing with. Thru all of this she kept up on a full-time job.

Like Pam, T, (as we all call her), is a fireball who, once committed, simply will not back down, and this included all his doctor visits, both here and in Huston, their travels to and from family on the east coast, all his chemo and all the ups and downs. T was totally committed to him, but everyone who knows her is not at all surprised. She simply knows no other way.

We rode many miles together over the years and the four of us traveled a lot, as close families do.

He was a fighter, a First Seargeant retired, Unites States Air Force with deployments in both Iraq wars, and he fought for each day of the last two years to make them all count.

He and I were kindred spirits; he fought Americas battles on foreign shores, I fought Americas battles on American shores, but we both fought those battles under the same flag with the same commitment to what that stands for.

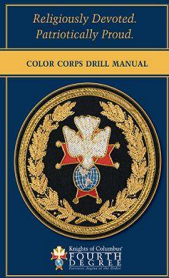
We said good bye to him a few Wednesdays past, from here he will travel to New Jersey for family there, and then to his final rest in Arlington.

When Teresa gets back from New Jersey and then Arlington, she will come home to a new grandson, and whole new way of life. This will take some time for her, but she’ll make it thru. She and Pam are fireballs, they’re kindred spirits.

And now another door has opened

In his mercy, the Lord ended Keith’s pain and suffering. In the last several years, Keith had come to Jesus, with much help from T, and so we know he is with Jesus now, and his suffering is over. I am happy for him, and in a way maybe just a little bit jealous, he made it home before me, and I’m 11 years older.

The Lord took Keiths life from Teresa, but almost in the same breath, gave her a new one to live her life with.

Think about this for a while, and, like me, you’ll get a little deeper glimpse of Gods great wisdom, it’s profound, and it brings us ever closer to the Lord.

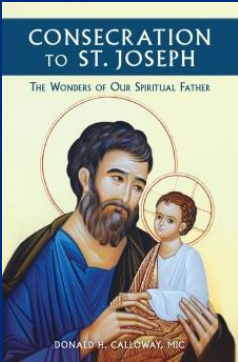

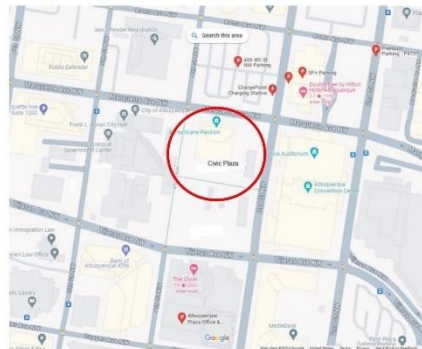

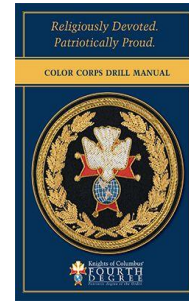

Displaying it on a flagpole is generally below the US flag if on the same pole, or to the left of the US and any other country flags.

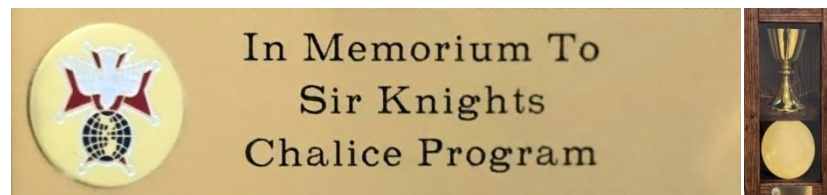

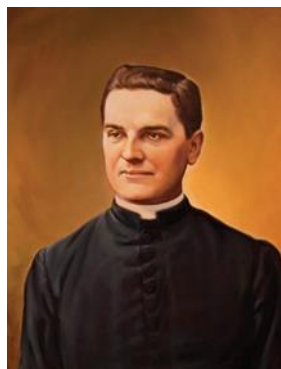
